NOTE: The Justice Department furnished the Bureau a a letter addressed to President Johnson written by of Dallas. She alleged she has been running for five years because policemen have been running her from city to city and she wanted to know if she could file a suit against the policemen, who have been "picking at me" for five years. The Department also furnished a copy of a letter over AAG Miller's signature which acknowledged her communication which indicated the Department would be of no assistance to her. Although it appears that Secret Service may already be aware of due to the fact that her letter was addressed to President Johnson, any additional information developed at Dallas should be furnished to Secret Service.
