NOTE: Correspondent is not identifiable in Bufiles. [redacted] Decatur, Georgia 30031, who sent

the nonsensical letter to Mr. Weatherby, has been known to the Bureau for some time. She has in the past forwarded somewhat similar letters to other public officials she apparently does not know. She was interviewed by a Bureau Agent on 7-30-64 and stated that the reasons she sent such a letter in the past was she believed a man she met at Atlanta, Georgia, is the assassin of President Kennedy. From this point on, her conversation was rambling and fanciful. She stated among other things that she was hypnotized and also had a "laying of hands on her." She admitted prior confinement for nine years in the Milledgeville State Hospital, Milledge, Georgia. Local authorities are aware of her nature. A condition card concerning her emotional instability is being placed in the Correspondence and Tours Section. (62-109060-3754).
