At the time of the murder Ruby was fatter than Oswald, but as time went on he became thinner and the resemblance increased, Could it be that they were blood relations? Oswald, Oswald's mother, and Ruby all looked very much alike as though they might be brothers and sisters (or sons of the same mother) Oswald's. I'm not sure of their ages but thought it possible that there could have been some family connection (even illegitimate that wasn't known.

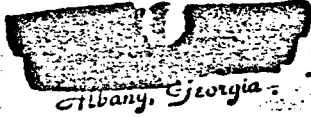
