The lead set forth in this letter at Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, was covered on February 25-26, 1965, but was inadvertently not reported in our subsequent communications because of the negative nature of the investigation. However, to complete all the investigative facets in Mexico, the negative inquiry has been forwarded as an insert.

No leads have been set out to locate and re-interview GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO, and this is being left to the discretion of the Dallas Office.
