SUMMARY OF BASIS FOR INQUIRY

On February 4, 1965, [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] Coahuila State Police, State Building,
Saltillo, Coahuila, advised that the Saltillo Police Depart-
ment had arrested the captioned individual on February 3,
1965, for being drunk and assaulting a woman at a local hotel.
Upon arrest, he resisted violently and shouted vulgar
expressions at the officers and raved and shouted that he
would kill the Governor of Coahuila and then shouted, "I
had something to do with President KENNEDY's death."

When interviewed on the same date, the captioned
individual when asked to explain his statement wherein he
allegedly had something to do with the death of President
KENNEDY and had threatened to kill the Governor of Coahuila,
GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated he did not recall making such
statements. He denied that he had anything to do with the
death of President KENNEDY and said he would most certainly
not kill the Governor of Coahuila.

Regarding his location on November 22, 1963,
GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he was in Guadalajara,
Jalisco, Mexico, working for the Benjamin Franklin Library
and a Mr. RYHAN SERGIO, 1401 Pedro Moreno Street. He stated
that he was acquainted with Attorney LOPEZ MORENO, who knew
that he was in Guadalajara at that time. LOPEZ MORENO has
offices on Morelos Street in Guadalajara.

GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he served in the
United States Air Force from 1949 to 1952 with Serial Number
5741055. He advised he had been given a medical discharge in
1952 from the Air Force, after having spent a number of weeks
in the Air Force general hospital at Mobile, Alabama, name
not recalled, where he was recovering from a nervous breakdown.

He advised he receives a pension for this disability and the checks are sent to his mother, ~~LOLA FONDOJA~~, at 1104 Victoria Street, Beaumont, Texas.

GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated he had been arrested on a number of occasions for being drunk and fighting, but could not recall the dates or places. The only serious crime with which he was charged was an attempted burglary charge from which he was released.

Dr. SAM SOUTHWELL, Director of the United States Information Service in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, advised that GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO was not known to him and was not known to have been around the Benjamin Franklin Library in Guadalajara. In order to be more thorough, he contacted the employees at the Benjamin Franklin Library and they all stated that GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO was not known to them.

A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised as follows:

Attorney MIGUEL LOPEZ MORENO, who has his office at Pedro Moreno 215, Office 110, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, stated he does not recall anyone by the name of GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO. He consulted his records on clients and could find no one by that name.

Dr. SERGIO JAIME, Director of the "Instituto Psiquiatrico Infantil," Calle Pedro Moreno 1401, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, advised that he does not remember a GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO either by name or as a patient or employee. He stated that his caretaker at the institute is MIGUEL GONZALEZ, who has worked for over two years for him.

Dr. JAIME resides at 13 de Septiembre 157, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, where he also has an office. He stated that his mother takes care of this office. A check was made with his mother and she could not remember anyone by the name of GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO.

A FEDERICO LOPEZ GUERRERO, who owns a shoe factory in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, stated he does not have any relative by the name of GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO.
