Re reports of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated 8/31/65 and 4/22/65 at Dallas, and Legat, Mexico City, letter to Bureau, 10/13/65, all in captioned assassination case.

Referenced Legat, Mexico City, letter transmitted a two-page insert relating to the assassination case and bearing the sub-heading "Allegations by GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO, also known as Gabriel James Lopez, Gabriel J. Lopez, Salvador Martinez, FBI No. 265951A, Saltillo Coahuila, Mexico." Twenty-five copies of this insert, together with two copies of referenced Legat, Mexico City letter were forwarded the Dallas Office by Bureau routing slip dated 10/20/65.

The Bureau's attention is called to pages 8 through 11 of referenced report of SA GEMBERLING dated 4/22/65 which reflects information concerning the allegations by GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO. The two-page insert enclosed with referenced Legat, Mexico City, letter does not appear to warrant inclusion in any report and a copy of such insert will be filed in Dallas file, UACB.

There are no outstanding leads at the present time in captioned assassination case, which since the early days of the assassination investigation has dealt mainly with miscellaneous allegations with respect to the assassination as it pertained to persons other than the assassin LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

The captioned file on LEE HARVEY OSWALD has been used by the Dallas Office with respect to investigation pertaining to

OSWALD as well as all evidence in the assassination case as it related to OSWALD, either directly or indirectly.

In view of the above, the captioned assassination case is being considered closed in the Dallas Office subject to being reopened in the event information is received in the Dallas Division or from other divisions, which should be included in a report.

The captioned OSWALD case will continue to be maintained in a pending status in order to follow the disposition of all evidence in this case as well as the proceedings with respect to the disposition of the assassination rifle and the revolver used by OSWALD in killing Dallas police officer J. D. TIPPIT.
