Dear Sir: Re The Assination of President Iennedy.
In my humble opinion the assasination of our beloved Presicent was the result of a Communist conspiracy, The :farren Commission Report notwithstanding. I base my ovinion upon confided information gained from a Janaican-born sister of mine who arrived in this country on Nov. 5. 1965 via i!exico after living in Cuba for nearly fortyseven years (Jan 1920 - Oct. 1965.) ity sister was a resident of Guantanamo, Giba for very many years up to last October.

Thout midfall of 1253 my sister found it necessary to Go to Havana for special medical treatment. Early in Hov. 1953 while she was still in Havana, a tall white man - an American met her and engaged her in a conversation. She discovered that the man was a Communist. fmong the remarks the man made this was the most stunning one: "Kennedy is coing to be killed sometime during the latter part of mov. or early Dec." rie was guite empiatical in malcing this remark. iy sister was very disturle. Sine did not knor viat to do sine said. She could not show an* emotion Eor reasons which I will give Further in this letter. Ny sister knew Erom that moment that the life of the EresiJent of the United States was endangered.

It was Tuesday Nov. 15, 1965, That she cave me the information and the first time we had seer, each other since June 1020.

I asked my sister why she didn't co quetly to the nnericin Smbassy and secretly report what the man had told her. She said there was no Naerican Embassy or Consulate in Havana or anywiere else in Cuba at tise time and slae vas afraid to no to the Sriss Fmbassir kecause Cubar Connurists were to je found rverrwiere. The Swiss Emiossy was then handing Jicricar affairs.

The following are some of the factors that should le consideres concerninc ny sister vinen slie was in cula.

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1.- ivy sister vas advanced in years - 53 in l?33.
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2. Ahe had all her five children (now married) registerea as Eritish subjects at kirth at the

Eritish Enbassu vioicia by aoreement is nov loo'ing after the dffairs of irdemendent Jamaican intionals in Cuba.
3. She and her family were under the surveillance of the Cuban Communists and Police who are violently anti-iduerican.
4. She aidd her family were suspected as heing proAmerican and more in sympathy with the antiCastroite Cubans.
3. She was ailing and confused.

A quick thinking person could probably have a secret messace sent to varn inashington of the threat to the Fresident's Iffe hy at least two wais (1) throurh the Fritish Mmbass:r ard (2) hasten back to Guantanamo and send words "underground" to relatives vorking at the raval Ease intended for imerican officials there. Iy sister had relatives working t the Base in 1963. Some of them are still working there. But as it can he seen, a cruel and an evil fate was working against the Eresident.

Fow lir. ittorney General this letter is verv conficontial. I.ike my sister. I was born in Jamaica, 1 . I. I have teen a resident of the United States since June 1920. I kecame a llaturalized American citizen on Jiarch 17. 1941 in U. 3: District Court, Southern N. V. I deem it mu duty to write tinis letter as a loyal U. S. citizer. Elease for God's sake (and we know you will not) do not divulce our names and adoresses (my sisters and mine) to the general public. newspapers, radio and television. We do not want our pictures to 'appear anywhere at all. Then $I$ told $m y$ sister at our second meeting that $I$ was going to write you she became disturbed ana fearful. Her son and $I$ had to calm her down. fife and our relatives here and in Cuba might be the objects of Communist vengeance and reprisals. fy sister has three sons with their families still in Cuba. He also have a sister with her husband overthere.

Hy sister is not living here with me. If you should desire to send any of your aikes to interview my sister secretly I could arrance to have my sister here on any Tuesday winen $I$ am off worle. But please give notice in advance. Everything should be done quietly. jo one else should come but your aides. Direction: I. ?. T. west side Newlots bound Subvay train to Ningston Ave. Station Nalk one block south along Kirgston jve to Union St.


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
