JOHN FOLEY of the office of the Chief Medical Examiner of New York City, 520 1st Avenue, NYC, contacted during the course of another investigation, advised that Miss Liveres Miss Gandy their office would be interested in obtaining the body of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. He feels the medical examiners of this office are the most qualified autopsy experts in this country performing over 30,000 each year, with many of the deaths being from gunshot wounds. He pointed out that this office is one of the most respected in the country regarding autopsies. This office is not interested in any publicity, but feels they could possibly put to rest the recent conjecture about the path of the bullet through the President's body. It was pointed out to Mr. FOLEY that the FBI does not have control of the body of the President and it would be necessary for their office to obtain the permission of President KENNEDY's family for any such examination. - The above is furnished for the information of the Bureau and any action deemed necessary.
