ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT

On December 12, 1966, the American Embassy,  
London, received a letter indicating the writer may  
have helpful information regarding the assassination  
of President Kennedy.

A confidential source of this office advised  
on December 29, 1966, that the writer of this letter  
is known to have an unsettled mental condition and  
given to acts of violence. At one time in the recent  
past the writer is known to have thrown a file at a  
British tax official. The writer is also known to have  
written numerous letters in the past regarding various  
non-specific complaints.
