No arrest record for Garcia was located in Identification Division files. New Orleans recheck indices, review its file 105-2171 and thereafter submit airtel with letterhead memorandum for dissemination attached containing summary of pertinent data concerning Garcia. No record of Blanca Versach, with whom Garcia may be living, was located in Bureau investigative files.

No identifiable information concerning Emilio Santana of Miami, Florida, was located in Bureau investigative files and no record of Santana was located in Identification Division files.
