stated that he talked to Krasts for about the state and found him to be very evasive. According to Krasts impressed him as being mentally disturbed, and possibly having psychotic or paranoid tendencies. During the conversation, Krasts stated that he was very suspicious of the individual in the letter but could only explain by saying that it was "a feeling" and that he felt the person was "hired by the FBI to execute him." He could furnish nothing as a basis for his suspicion other than his "feeling."
