"I never beard of Oswald metil on television (AHH) the sosassination." Russo said in the Interview. Be said Ferrie never mentioned Oswald's name.

Russo, a 25-year-old insurance salesman now living in Baton : Rouge, told a three-judge state court earlier Tuesday that he heard Lee Harvey Oswald, Clay Shaw and David Ferrie plotting to assassinate President Kennoły.

Russo also said in the interview that "Ferrie was obsessed with Kennedy and the idea of what he was doing to Cube or Castra."
