'Plot' Case Observers:
Keep Lips Buttoned

IN THE CURRENT MODERN VERSION of "Who killed Cork Robin?" in which our district attorney Jim Garrison, is second-guessing the very long record of the Warren Commission's investigation and its conclusion that only Lee Harvey Oswald was responsible for firing the shots that killed President Kennedy; this verdict was generally and widely accepted when it was first made public. But the pale cast of doubt insisted upon obscuring the situation.

For one thing, the murder of Oswald by Jack Ruby before hundreds of presential witnesses and who knows how many million televiewers suggested at once that the necessity of silencing Oswald before he could sing to the authorities like a mockingbird underlay this thing.

The whirlwind shift of developments brought to light officially by the Garrison probe has been too rapid to be followed by intelligent comment until long after the observations have lost all point. The only safe course for an observer who relies upon the printed word to communicate his views to the public, is to say nothing at great length and with ponderous profundity, avoiding all categorical statements.
