CLAY 1. SHAW HAD REQUESTED THE ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA FOR
SATURDAY EVENING POST AUTHOR JAMES PHELAN. IT STATES
HIS TESTIMONY WAS "ESSENTIAL TO THE DEFENSE". THE DEFENSE
QUOTED THE LONG PASSAGES FROM THE POST ARTICLE AS BASIS FOR
THE MOTION. THE MOTION CONTAINED STATEMENTS MADE TO THE
DISTRICT ATTORNEY
AUTHOR BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF DA'S OFFICE.

THE ITEM CONTINUED THAT PHELAND WOULD BE ASKED "TO GIVE A DEPOSITION IN OPEN COURT FOLLOWING FORTYEIGHT HOURS NOTICE BY THE DEFENSE AND DA'S OFFICE. FURTHER, IF PHELAN WILL NOT VOLUNTARILY APPEAR, THE MOTIONS ASKS THAT HE BE MAY 2 PLACED UNDER BOND AND BROUGHT TO NEW ORLEANS UNTIL TESTIMONY CAN BE TAKEN". THE MOTION; WAS FILED BEFORE CLERK OF THE

COURT.
