Karvin Vatson called me at 3 p.u. today. He is at home attempting to got some rest while the President in on the Island of Guan.

Vatson told so that two sources, one being Jack Valenti, bend of the Notion Picture Association, have advised him that District Attorney James Garrison in New Orleans is new attempting to counset Clay Shay with Malter Jealins. Watson stated that one of Valenti's Emiroes is the wife of Jacon James, a cousin of Valenti. The wife works for the New Orleans "State's Riem."

Catson stated that, involue as he and the President were concerned, there was no truth to this ratter, but he wanted to know if we had any information along this line. I told Vatcon we had received no such information.

Vatson then taked what we thought about investigating the allegation. I told his I thought it would be unnecessarily giving rise to considerable rumors and I felt that investigation of this nature would be unterstanded. I told him of District Atterney Carrison's statements concerning putting handsuffs on FMI agents, and of Garrison's rather childish attempts to bur the FDI from learning any of his so-called information. I also told watson that no action should be taken which would allow Garrison to indicate that the FDI or the Federal Covernment had interfered with his investigation. I stated this is exactly that Garrison is looking for in an attempt to emplain his own failure.

Watson agreed with these statements and indicated that no action should be taken unless the President indicates to the contrary when he discusses the eatter with his.
