On April 28, 1967, a source in the New Orleans Office who has provided reliable information in the past advised that an individual who has homosexual tendencies had provided to this source the following information:

Approximately seven years ago the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office, raided the Yuga Carnival Ball and arrested approximately one hundred homesexuals who were in attendance at this ball. District Attorney Jin Garrison has obtained the names of these individuals and is currently interviewing them in an effort to determine if there is a homosexual in the New Orleans area who looks like Clay Shaw. Clay Shaw has been indicted on a conspiracy charge alleging that he entered into a conspiracy to kill President Kennedy.

The source volunteered an opinion that apparently Garrison is in difficulty with his investigation and is possibly "looking for an out." The source indicated that apparently Clay Shaw is giving Garrison such a tough fight that he may come up with information that there was a wrong identification of Shaw.
