Nathaniel Kossack, number one man to Assistant Attorney General Vinson, called me this morning to indicate that the United States Attorney's Office in New Orleans would early this morning appear before the grand jury with a motion to quash the subpoena calling Special Agent Regis Kennedy for testimony.

If the grand jury denies the motion, the United States Attorney's Office already has prepared a writ of certiorari. An immediate attempt will, of course, be made to move this matter to the Federal courts in the event the grand jury acts arbitrarily.

Kossack stated that under no circumstances would the Department allow Garrison to pull a smart one in this matter.
