ASSASSINATION OF
PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY,
DALLAS, TEXAS, NOVEMBER 22, 1963

At 5:10 p. m. on May 8, 1967, Carlos Quiroga, 3134 Derby Place, New Orleans, Louisiana, telephonically advised the New Orleans Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that a subpoena to appear before the Orleans Parish Grand Jury, New Orleans, Louisiana, on May 10, 1967, had been delivered for him at his home that day.

Carlos Quiroga is a Cuban exile who has been active in anti-Castro activity in New Orleans and who was previously questioned in connection with the inquiry of Orleans Parish District Attorney James Garrison into the death of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy.
