THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, ORLEANS PARISH, OPPOSED
THE MOTION TO QUASH. JUDGE BAGERT SET A HEARING ON THE
MOTION FOR MAY SIXTEEN NEXT IN CIMINAL DISTRICT COURT, PARISH
OF-ORLEANS, AND FILED A STAY ON THE ANSWERING OF THE SUBPOENA
TO APPEAR BEFORE THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY BY SA REGIS L.
