On 5-5-67 the District Attorney's office in Orleans Parish served a subpoena on Special Agent Regis Kennedy to appear to give testimony before the grand jury on 5-10-67.

ASAC J. Sylvester, New Orleans, advised 5-10-67 that the U.S. Attorney made a motion to quash the subpoena before Judge Bernard Bagertt of Orleans Parish. The motion was opposed by District Attorney James Garrison's office and the judge granted a stay of execution on the subpoena served on Special Agent Kennedy and ordered a hearing to be held before him on Tuesday, 5-16-67.
