Judge Bagert ordered SA Kennedy to report to the Orleans Grand Jury at 2 p.m. today. SAC Rightmyer advised that SA Kennedy will appear before the grand jury this afternoon. He will plead Departmental Order 324-64 to any question asked of him relating to any knowledge acquired during an official investigation. Thereafter, in the event it is necessary, the U.S. Attorney is prepared to file motions to have the case removed to U.S. District Court.
