For the information of Legat, Manila, Bufiles contain the following information concerning Lillie Mae Hollins. A material witness warrant for her arrest was issued by Chicago United District Attorney James Garrison, New Orleans, in connection with his investigation of the alleged conspiracy in the assassination of President Kennedy. According to the United World-News, Omaha, Nebraska, 5/27/67, Mrs. Hollins, also known as Sandra Knight, formerly a resident of New Orleans but then a resident of Omaha, became involved in the investigation when she disputed testimony given two weeks previously in New Orleans by her witness Perry Russo. The latter, when testifying during a preliminary hearing for Clay L. Shaw, said that Mrs. Hollins had been one of several individuals at a party in the apartment of David V. Ferris during September, 1963. Russo testified that at the party he heard Ferris, Lee Harvey Oswald and Shaw conspire to kill President Kennedy. According to the newspaper article, Mrs. Hollins told Russo that she did not meet Ferris until 1965.
