SUMMARY INFORMATIVE NOTE

Carlos Quiroga, an anti-Castro Cuban national, visited Lee Harvey Oswald in August, 1963, to determine extent of Oswald's connection with Fair Play for Cuba. Jim Garrison learned of this visit and has indicated that this shows that Oswald was connected with anti-Castro Cubans and was not pro-Castro. Garrison has previously tried to get Quiroga to admit this without success.

Garrison has been trying to get Sergio Arcacha Smith, anti-Castro Cuban, extradited to appear before the grand jury. Apparently Garrison thinks he can force Arcacha to testify that he worked for Central Intelligence Agency prior to the Kennedy assassination.

The attached lengthy teletype consists primarily of a summary of another article in which Garrison accuses the Central Intelligence Agency of covering up the facts as to who actually assassinated John F. Kennedy, and even states that Oswald did not kill Kennedy. He claims that there were three men shooting from front and rear who assassinated Kennedy.

Such ludicrous statements by Garrison are in keeping with the manner in which he has conducted himself during his so-called investigation. The attached will not be disseminated since it is news media material.
