- 1. Reference is made to your memorandum, File Number (S) 62-109060, dated May 25, 1967, Subject: Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas.
- 2. Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), has had no contact with Jim Garrison, District Attorney, Parish of Orleans, nor with a "Mr. Weiss," or with "Gordon Novel." There has been no contact by DIA with the Attorneys Plotkin, Alvarez, Sapir, mentioned in the transcript provided by Mr. Garrison to the Special Agent in Charge, Mr. Rightmyer, of the New Orleans office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

3. DIA, having no contact with any of the individuals mentioned and no contact with the Louisiana Army National Guard, is unable to interpret the meaning of the remarks in the last paragraph of the transcript. DIA has no personnel stationed in New Orleans or Louisiana. Request DIA be advised if any further information is developed in this matter.
