Airtel to Albany RE: Charles Phillip Sowell

Other: Attached letter is not being answered. Through Naval Intelligence, New Orleans, Louisiana, a card dated 1-21-67 was received in the Bureau written by Sowell from Laredo, Texas, which included the statements "they say pay for President Kennedy's murder was peanuts! Check private and Post Office M.O. records. Pres. L. B. Johnson is in on murder gang."

The Secret Service was informed of this fact on 1-30-67. Sowell, furnishing his full name as Charles Phillip Sowell, was interviewed by our San Antonio Office on referral from the Harlingen, Texas, Police Department on 3-6-67, inasmuch as he had intimated that he had facts regarding President Kennedy's assassination. He appeared emotionally unstable and made nonsensical statements. He was described as white; 43 years of age; height, 5'8"; eyes, hazel; hair, wavyy brown, worn shoulder length; merchant seaman. Related information was again furnished United States Secret Service on 3-16-67, That agency is being furnished a copy of attached letter, and in making the substance of this communication known to local law enforcement officials, direct the attention of your contact to the fact Sowell mentions possible suicide.
