8. Garrison's Investigation

Lima news media continued their detailed coverage of New Orleans District Attorney Jim GARRISON's investigation of the KENNEDY assassination. La Prensa on May 22 ran the headline: "Agents of the CIA Killed Kennedy, Asserts the District Attorney". On May 19 Correo headlined: "The Plot Against Kennedy -- District Attorney Jim Garrison Reveals: Oswald and Ruby Were Agents of the CIA. They Knew One Another". El Comercio ran a headline similar to La Prensa's over the same AFP release. On following day La Cronica led off its Kennedy story with "The Kennedy Case Takes an Explosive Turn with Garrison's Accusations of the CIA". El Comercio ran a UPI release with the lead: "U.S. Lawyer Says that the District Attorney Jim Garrison is 'A Very Dangerous Man'". (UNCLASSIFIED)

Comment: It appears that Garrison has only to make a statement in order to receive front-page headline treatment by the Lima press. (UNCLASSIFIED)
