On 6/1/67, SA KENNETH A. LEARY was interviewing
 DON TURRENTINE, Security Department, Texaco, Inc., 6400
 Southwest Freeway, Houston, Texas, in connection with
 various matters involving use of Texaco Credit Cards.

While interview was in progress, TURRENTINE
 received call from another employee of his office and was
 heard to make statements concerning CLAY SHAW.

TURRENTINE then voluntarily stated his office
 had recently received requests from office of District
 Attorney JIM GARRISON at New Orleans and had been re-
 quested to attempt to locate any possible record of pur-
 chases made by CLAY SHAW of New Orleans utilizing Texaco
 Credit Cards. TURRENTINE stated his employee had just
 reported he had been unable to locate any such information
 and this report would subsequently be relayed to the office
