ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, NOVEMBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS

Richard Halstead, Wyoming Highway Patrolman, Wamsutter, Wyoming, telephonically furnished the following information on June 4, 1967, to a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation:

At about 10:30 p.m., June 3, 1967, he stopped in color, bearing Nevada license W 68105, on Interstate Highway 80 near Wamsutter, because the car had only one but he is not required to appear in court and is merely next town, Rawlins, Wyoming.

The driver who was traveling alone, identified himself as Gerald Lee Morrison, and said he was traveling to Washington, D. C., to see Senator Robert Kennedy, since he had information concerning the assassination of president Kennedy. Morrison stated that he had talked with Lee Salt Lake City. Morrison's Nevada driver's license, number GM 410528, disclosed he was born May 28, 1941, is a white and blue eyes. His residence address is 332 Colorado River Boulevard, Reno, Nevada.

A bill of sale revealed he had purchased the Motor Co., 2401 South Virginia, Reno, Nevada.
