May Change T&C Name to 'Price Is Right'

The chairman of "Truth and Consequences" said today the group may change its name to "The Price Is Right."

"We're for justice at any price — that's our purpose," said businessman Joseph Rault Jr., who has been heading the T&C group financing the investigation by District Attorney Jim Garrison of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

The group has to change its name because a Garrison foe, attorney Dean A. Andrews Jr., moved to register the corporate name "Truth and Consequences Inc.," thus depriving the Garrison group of the right to use it.

"Since Andrews has the name, he can also take over defense of the suit filed by Gordon Novel against Truth and Consequences," said Rault. Novel sued the T&C group on the grounds that Garrison was depriving him of his rights, using T&C money.

Rault said it was "only a coincidence" that the names of his group are similar to television programs. As an alternative, Rault said, they might continue to use the old name by changing it slightly to "Truth and Consequences of New Orleans."
