SAC Lee Teague of the Oklahoma City Office called on June 8, 1967. According to SAC Teague, former Special Agent Norman Bagwell has numerous contacts among the news media in Oklahoma City. Bagwell approached SAC Teague noting that television station WWL in New Orleans, Louisiana, did a 60-minute special on the "Garrison investigation" on May 22, 1967. Bagwell advised that the same show would be presented in Oklahoma City and he offered to make a copy of the video tape available to SAC Teague if the Bureau was interested. SAC Teague noted that Bagwell would have to reproduce the tape himself, probably at a cost of several hundred dollars, which he would be willing to do.

I advised SAC Teague that the Bureau's position from the very start has been to stay out of the Garrison investigation and under the circumstances it did not appear that there would be sufficient value for the Bureau in the telecast to justify having Bagwell undertake the expense of reproducing it.
