ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT  
JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY  
DALLAS, TEXAS, 11/22/63

An individual who has provided reliable information in the past advised on June 20, 1967 that it is rumored in the New Orleans French Quarter that District Attorney James Garrison, Parish of Orleans, received a "section 8" discharge from U. S. Army.

This source advised that this information is a rumor and not personal knowledge.


The same source advised that additional information has been received as to the possible reason why District Attorney Garrison selected Clay Shaw as the subject of his investigation into the assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy. Source advised that approximately two weeks before Clay Shaw was arrested by Garrison as a conspirator in the Kennedy assassination, Garrison was in Brennan's Restaurant with his wife and created a disturbance and a scene in which he threw a glass of wine at his wife and Clay Shaw was present and interceded in the family argument. The source advised that Garrison at this time threatened Clay Shaw.

Source advised that this is not personal knowledge but it is understood that Miss Brennan, proprietor of Brennan's Restaurant, a table captain and a waiter witnessed this scene. Source stated that this was not personal information.
