ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY,
NOVEMBER 22, 1963,
DALLAS, TEXAS

On June 20, 1967, [redacted] appeared at the FBI Resident Agency at Gulfport, Mississippi, and advised that during Christmas of 1962, she was visiting a [redacted] in Albuquerque, New Mexico, and while she was at the [redacted] residence in Albuquerque, a meeting was held between [redacted] his son [redacted] Lee Harvey Oswald, and another unidentified man.

She was told the day after this meeting by the wife of [redacted] that the meeting was held to plan the assassination of President Kennedy.

Prior to this meeting, [redacted] had discussed in her presence, the possible assassination of President Kennedy and mentioned using a high powered rifle with a telescopic site to accomplish this purpose. [redacted] stated she was not present at the meeting where she claims Oswald was present and does not know what was discussed at the meeting.

[redacted] explained that her association with the [redacted] goes back about eight years when she used to do some typing for [redacted] who is the author of a book named [redacted]. She said that she once reported [redacted] to the FBI in Santa Fe, New Mexico, for passing out subversive literature on the campus of the University of New Mexico.

[redacted] stated that she had failed to report this meeting in the past because her former husband [redacted] present whereabouts unknown, advised her not to get involved. li.

[REDACTED] admitted that in July, 1965, a warrant was issued for her arrest in Fort Worth, Texas, for a bad check charge, but she has never returned to Fort Worth so the warrant could be executed. She further admitted that in 1952, a warrant was issued for her for bad checks in Missouri, county unknown. She admitted being arrested on two occasions in Fort Worth, Texas, on drunk charges. She states that on one occasion in Fort Worth, Texas, she was under treatment for a "nervous ailment" for which she was taking medication prescribed by a doctor, and this was the reason for one of the drunk arrests.
