admitted that in July, 1965, a warrant was issued for her arrest in Fort Worth, Texas, for a bad check charge, but she has never returned to Fort Worth so the warrant could be executed. She further admitted that in 1952, a warrant was issued for her for bad checks in Missouri, county unknown. She admitted being arrested on two occasions in Fort Worth, Texas, on drunk charges. She states that on one occasion in Fort Worth, Texas, she was under treatment for a "nervous ailment" for which she was taking medication prescribed by a doctor, and this was the reason for one of the drunk arrests.
