INFORMATIVE NOTE

Date June 22, 1967

The attached communication states Garrison believes 14-man Cuban refugee group behind assassination. This same information was received several weeks ago and nothing new appears to have been added. We know of an anti-Cuban group which arrived in New Orleans from Miami in Summer of 1963. We interviewed leader of group who indicated he had hired such men to work in a lumber industry in Guatemala. We found no evidence Lee Harvey Oswald had anything to do with this group or that group involved in assassination. Data concerning group was disseminated to the Warren Commission and also has been disseminated to the Department.
