on June 23, 1967, a confidential source, contact with whom has been insufficient upon which to judge the reliability of his information, advised on the night of June 9, 10, 1967, Andrew Scambria, First Assistant District Attorney to District Attorney James Garrison, stayed at the Holiday Inn in Lafayette, Louisiana, apparently under an assumed name and was accompanied by a woman in her mid-twenties, who is believed to have been Marlene Mancusco, ex-wife of Gordon Mayel.

Source stated Scambra apparently went to the races at Evangeline Downs and conducted some interviews at television station KATC, Channel 3, while in Lafayette. Scambria was interested in the "Bob Hamm Special report" concerning "Garrison and the Mafia."
