[redacted] advised on 6/6/67 that he was recently visited by an individual who identified himself as an investigator for the District Attorney's Office in New Orleans, La. This investigator, who source believes is named SMITH, was requested by his boss, JAMES GARRISON, to show four pictures to the source for any information he may have concerning them. The first picture the investigator exhibited was a picture of JACK RUBY in a sports shirt supposedly taken in New Orleans in 1963. The investigator asked the source if he recognized this person. The source advised he did recognize him to be JACK RUBY as he had seen his picture in the newspaper on a number of occasions. Source believes that the investigator also asked if he had seen RUBY and the below described Cuban together in the French Quarter in New Orleans.

The second picture the investigator showed the source was of a Latin looking individual in his early to mid-twenties. This individual was heavy set. Source was asked if he could identify this person as the Cuban who was photographed with LEE HARVEY OSWALD in front of the International Trade Mart in New Orleans prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY. Source advised the investigator that he was not able to identify this person.

FIRST NAME UNKNOWN

The investigator exhibited a picture of an individual believed to be called (FNU) HALL. This person appeared to be in his mid-twenties, slim build, narrow face, beard around the chin area and was smoking a cigar. The investigator asked the source if he had seen this person with any Cubans or with SERGIO ARCACHA in New Orleans in 1961 or 1962. Source advised him that he had never seen this person before.

The last picture exhibited by the investigator was a picture of an American who appeared to be in his mid-twenties, light eyes, dirty blond hair, slim face and clean shaven. The investigator did not make any comments which would indicate a connection of this individual with this case. Source advised that the general description fit that of GORDON NOVEL, but was not this individual. Source added that it was his impression that the photograph of RUBY may have been taken after he shot OSWALD because RUBY appeared somewhat thinner in the photograph than the picture he had seen of RUBY previously prior to the assassination. Source stated that the investigator from GARRISON's office asked no further questions at this time.

Cuba
Source advised that he was recently visited by CARLOS BRINGUIER, Head of the Cuban Student Directorate, New Orleans, La. BRINGUIER advised the source he had proof that GARRISON was dismissed from the Armed Forces at the time of the Korean War as he was considered mentally unfit. BRINGUIER added that GARRISON had a Napoleonic complex.

██████████ requested that the above information not be disseminated as it was received on a person-to-person basis and such dissemination might compromise his position.
