SPECIAL AGENT REED W. JENSEN HAS ADVISED THAT HIS SON,
AGE FOURTEEN, WHO WAS AT THE JENSEN RESIDENCE, ONE
TWO ZERO EIGHT MILAN STREET, AT APPROXIMATELY FOUR THIRTY
PM TODAY WAS HANDED A SUBPOENA AND WAS TOLD TO GIVE THE
DOCUMENT TO HIS FATHER.

THE SUBPOENA IS DATED AUGUST ONE, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN,
AND IS IDENTIFIED AS A SECTION G SUBPOENA AND IDENTIFIES
THE STATE CASE AS NUMBER ONE NINE EIGHT-FOUR EIGHT THREE
THIS SUBPOENA COMMANDS REED W. JENSEN TO APPEAR IN THE
CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT FOR THE PARISH OF ORLEANS, SECTION G,
ON THE NINTH DAY OF AUGUST, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, TO TESTIFY
TO THE TRUTH ACCORDING TO HIS KNOWLEDGE IN THE CASE OF THE
STATE OF LOUISIANA VS. DEAN A. ANDREWS, JR., DEFENDANT.
