Dean A. Andrews told the Warren Commission that while under heavy sedation he received a call from a Clay Bertrand requesting that Andrews represent Lee Harvey Oswald following the Kennedy Assassination. He later told the Commission that he must have dreamed the incident.

Jim Garrison's entire case against Clay L. Shaw hinges on the idea that he is the mysterious Clay Bertrand. Andrews has told several conflicting stories as to the actual existence of Bertrand. This information will not be disseminated since it is from news media material.
