SUBJECT: The Congressional Record

Pages H10949-H10951. Congressman Ford, (R) Michigan, spoke concerning the series of four documentary programs captioned "The Warren Report" recently presented by the Columbia Broadcasting System (CBS). He advised that millions of Americans watched the CBS programs, however, other millions did not have the opportunity and this material should be made available for all to read. He stated "Because the transcript of the four programs is lengthy, I will place it in the Congressional Record in eight daily installments." The first installment was inserted in the Record. This material appeared in earlier issues of the Congressional Record and was set forth in the memorandum on the particular Record inasmuch as references to the FBI are contained in the material.
