Domestic Intelligence Division INFORMATIVE NOTE 9/21/67 On 9/26/67, attorneys for Clay L. Shaw asked for either a six month continuance of Shaw's conspiracy trial or a change of venue. Shaw is under indictment for allegedly having conspired to assassinate John F. Kennedy. His attorneys pointed out that from the day of Shaw's arrest, Jim Garrison began a deliberate and calculated publicity barrage against Shaw on a local, nationwide and worldwide basis. They said that this resulted in almost daily coverage by the news media. A defense motion declared that it would be impossible to get a fair trial now be impossible to get a fair trial now or in the near future.
