Your attention is also called to Bureau airtel to all offices dated February 24, 1967, which instructed that no active investigation concerning the Garrison matter is to be conducted. Make certain Agents of the Charlotte Office are thoroughly familiar with the Bureau instructions in this matter. REL:45 (4) ROTE: Dr. John Edward Mc Intosh telephonically contacted the Asheville, North Carolina Resident Agency and indicated he was a friend of Jim Garrison and was acquainted with an individual who is a close friend and associate of Clay Shaw. Mc Intosh intimated through his contacts he had a direct line of information from Clay Shaw. Dr. Mc Intosh is hospitalized at a psychological clinic in Asheville and is an admitted drug addict. Charlotte planned to contact Dr. 1 to determine if Dr. Mc Intosh is mentally competent to be interviewed regarding any information wod he might have that would be of assistance to the FBI.
