Mr. Russell Frewu, News Director of WFIU television station in Bloomington, Indiana, telephonically contacted my office on 10-25-67 and requested comments from the FBI as to statements by New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison appearing in the October, 1967, issue of "Playboy" magazine. Mr. Frewu stated the television station desired to do a documentary presenting both sides in the controversy raised by Garrison in regard to the assassination of President Kennedy. Frewu was advised that absolutely no comment could be made in this connection.

Mr. Frewu then asked if the FBI could make any general comment concerning its investigation of the assassination. He was advised that the results of the investigation conducted by the FBI were made available to the Warren Commission.
