There is enclosed one copy of VA Form 10-2322 bearing the signature of CLYDE S. VAUGHAN.

On 11/9/67, Mr. THURMAN GREGORY, Assistant Registrar, VA Hospital, Waco, Texas, advised that a review of their file pertaining to CLYDE S. VAUGHAN, VA Claim No. 11-472-705, reveals that they have no handwriting or handprinting of VAUGHAN with the exception of his signature on several documents. Mr. GREGORY removed VA Form 10-2322 which is a "Clearance Sheet" from VAUGHAN's file which bears his signature and his address in VAUGHAN's handwriting and handprinting. The other writing on this sheet was made by VA employees.

Mr. GREGORY requested that this form be returned to him.

On 11/9/67, GENE SIMPSON, Contact Office, VARO, Waco, Texas, advised that a review of the records of that office fails to reflect a claim file located at that office for VAUGHAN. Mr. SIMPSON stated that unless they have had a recent claim from VAUGHAN his file would have been forwarded to the Federal Records Center at St. Louis, Mo., to be filed with the inactive records.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to compare the handwriting and handprinting of VAUGHAN which appears on VA Form 10-2322 with the handwriting and handprinting appearing in the address book which was furnished to the Houston Office by BILL IRICK and which allegedly pertains to the assassination of President KENNEDY. Upon completion of this handwriting comparison, the VA form should be returned to San Antonio for return to the VA Hospital.
