Dear Mr. Hoover,

I just saw District Attorney Garrison (New Orleans) on a television interview regarding the assination of President Kennedy. He stated that the F. B. I. had been informed of the "plot" and that you knew of the information; that TWX's were sent to inform other F. B. I. agents. The part that upsets me is that he implied that the President had not been informed and that Federal interference would be a problem in this investigation.

It is extremely difficult for me to imagine negligence on your part (or your associates') in such a vital matter, or that deliberate interference of justice would be initiated. So please, Mr. Hoover, when you have time - I know how busy you are - write to me what really happened.
