## 2 Subpnaed In DA's Probe Called to Court

Two California men subpnaed by Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison in his probe of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy have been ordered into court.

Lawrence Howard Jr., 32, of El Monte, near Los Angeles, yesterday was ordered to show cause Jan. 16 why he shouldn't testify here. The order was signed by Superior Court Judge Richard Schauer.

The request for Howard's appearance here was accompanied by a check for almost \$400—the price of a round-trip ticket.

And a check for \$405 was received by Kern County officials

at Bakersfield, accompanied by a letter requesting Kern County Dist. Atty. Kit Neison to obtain a court order directing the appearance here of Loren Hall.

Judge P. R. Borden has ordered a hearing on the New Orleans request on Jan. 10 in the Kern County Superior Court.

Hall has denied knowledge of an assassination plot, but has said he would come to New Orleans if a court order is issued. However, he can ask the court not to issue such an order, in which event he would be required to show cause why the

order should not be issued.

Dist. Atty. Garrison contends Hall was associated with Lee Harvey Oswald and Jack Ruby in Dallas. He contends Hall checked into the Dallas YMCA in October, 1963, and did not leave Dallas until after the assassination.
