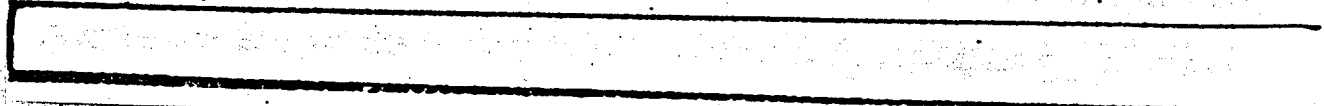

TODAY THE EDITOR OF THE SACRAMENTO UNION, A DAILY NEWSPAPER  
OF GENERAL CIRCULATION, TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED THAT A WHITE MALE  
WHO GAVE THE APPEARANCE OF BEING A EUROPEAN HAD COME TO HIS  
OFFICE STATING HE WISHED TO RELAY A MESSAGE TO THE NEW YORK TIMES  
TO THE EFFECT THAT "HE WAS IN TROUBLE AGAIN BECAUSE HE KNEW TOO  
MUCH CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY." THIS  
INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] DAVIS, CALIFORNIA, CARE OF [REDACTED]. THE EDITOR OF  
THE SACRAMENTO UNION TOLD [REDACTED] THAT HE KNEW THE NEW YORK TIMES  
REPRESENTATIVE IN SAN FRANCISCO AND THAT HE COULD RELAY THIS  
INFORMATION TO HIM AND ASKED [REDACTED] IF THERE WAS ANY SPECIFIC

EDITOR OF SACRAMENTO UNION DESCRIBED [REDACTED] AS WHITE MALE SIX FEET, THIRTY-FIVE - FORTY, LIGHT COLORED BUSHY HAIR, PALE COMPLEXION.
