Bureau files show one [redacted] of Bronx, New York, between January and September, 1967, has contacted our offices in Wyoming and New York to advise he was working for Vice President Humphrey on the Mafia, local police in Helsinki were trying to kill his mother, and that the FBI was to accept all messages for him. During one interview at the New York Office, he appeared highly nervous and agitated and on one occasion broke down and cried. The interviewing Agent observed [redacted] indicated he suffered from a mental condition. Dallas advised their files contain no references to [redacted].

In light of above, Sacramento is being advised of above and that [redacted] is not to be interviewed.
