Re Bureau airtel to Dallas dated 12/5/67, enclosing copy of letter dated 12/1/67, from EDWIN L. WEISL, JR., Assistant Attorney General, Civil Division, who requested certain information relating to civil complaints filed by JOHN J. KING and MARINA N. OSWALD PORTER.

Enclosed are 10 copies of a letterhead memorandum containing information relating to 6.5 mm. Mannlicher-Carcano rifle, Serial No. C2766, and .38 Special Smith and Wesson revolver, Serial No. V510210, which should be of assistance to the Department in defending a civil suit captioned John J. King vs. United States of America (U.S.D.C. Colorado, Civil Action No. 67-C-518).

The Bureau's attention is called to Dallas airtel to Bureau dated 1/3/68, captioned as above, wherein the Bureau was furnished copies of four receipts relating to the two weapons mentioned above. The Bureau may desire to forward to the Department, along with enclosed letterhead memorandum, a copy of each of the two receipts bearing the date of 11/22/63, showing receipt of the two weapons by Bureau personnel on 11/22/63.
