Re Dallas telephone call to Bureau 1/3/68, concerning documents relating to the possession of the assassination rifle and revolver of LEE HARVEY OSWALD referred to in forfeiture proceedings; and Dallas airtel to Bureau dated 11/18/65, which enclosed two copies of a letter dated 11/18/65 to the USA, Ft. Worth, Texas, setting forth a chronology reflecting location of the assassination rifle and OSWALD revolver for period 11/22/63 through 11/18/65.

Enclosed for the Bureau are two copies each of the following described receipts contained in Dallas file:

Dallas PD receipt dated 11/22/63, reflecting receipt by SA VINCENT E. DRAIN of .38 Smith and Wesson snub nose, SN 510210 and two .38 caliber shells at 11:45 p.m. 11/22/63. (Dallas file 89-43-1A 251.)

Dallas PD receipt dated 11/22/63, reflecting receipt on that date by SA VINCENT E. DRAIN of one 6.5 lever action rifle, SN C2766 and two spent hulls from 6th Floor of Texas School Book Depository. (Dallas file 89-43-1A 253.)

Receipt signed by Chief of Police J. E. GERRY, Dallas PD at 3:40 p.m., 11/24/63, and witnessed by SA VINCENT E. DRAIN, reflecting return to Dallas PD of several items included among which were the .38 caliber Smith and Wesson revolver, SN 510210 and rifle SN C2766. (Dallas file 89-43-1A 34.)
