Reference Mr. Hoover's letter to the Office of Senator Robert Kennedy, December 27, 1967, copy to San Francisco, enclosing letter from [REDACTED] dated November 12, 1967.

San Francisco office indices disclose no information identifiable with captioned individual. Records of the Oakland Police Department disclose that [REDACTED] was born April 21, 1928, in Texas, residing at [REDACTED], Oakland, self-employed owner of an employment agency.

Records of the Greater East Bay Credit Bureau disclose that [REDACTED] of [REDACTED], Oakland, is married to [REDACTED], who was born [REDACTED]. He is self-employed and she is employed at the San Francisco Naval Shipyard. [REDACTED]

No additional inquiry is being made. Appropriate authorities have been notified of the alleged threats to the life of subject and wife, and San Francisco is taking no further action.
